

<u>UNBC Faculty Association Lounge (UNBC-FAL)</u> <u>Rules and Regulations</u>

<u>Location</u>: The UNBC-FAL can be found in the SE corner of the second floor of the cafeteria and entrance to the lounge requires an active employee ID card.

Please read through the following rules carefully, fill-out and sign the form at the bottom, and return to: Art Fredeen, Rm 8-237, ESM Program.

Your activation should take < 1week from submission of this form.

UNBC-FAL rules and responsibilities:

- 1) The UNBC-FAL is open to all UNBC-FA members. UNBC-based adjunct professors and postdoctoral fellows also have access to the UNBC-FAL.
- 2) Members should be considerate of others while in the lounge area. Since many will be using the lounge as a quiet place to work or converse with colleagues or guests, members should refrain from prolonged cell-phone use or other distracting activities in the lounge unless other members are in accord or an advertised event is in session.
- 3) Members should, in general, leave the lounge in the same or better condition as found.
- 4) UNBC-FAL furnishings and equipment (vacuum, cleaning items, serving dishes, vases, candles and candle-holders etc.) are for UNBC-FAL use only and must not leave the lounge area.
- 5) In general, the UNBC-FAL is not a bookable space; *however*, events relating to UNBC-FA members can be held in the UNBC-FAL on a one-off or on a recurring basis provided the following criteria are met:
 - a. must be approved by the UNBC-FAL committee (contact: Art Fredeen @ x5847, fredeena@unbc.ca)
 - b. must be advertised by posting notices on the door of the UNBC-FAL 24h in advance.
 - c. liquor/food services regulations <u>are</u> obeyed (see below). These are posted in the Lounge on the bulletin board.
- 6) The UNBC-FAL is licensed, but only for alcohol purchased from the UNBC food services, e.g. drinks for sale in the cafeteria can be consumed in the UNBC-FAL. *Please* read the liquor license if you are planning an event that involves alcohol in the UNBC-FAL. Food regulations must also be followed.

- 7) Guests of the UNBC-FAL members are permitted, but they must be in the company of an UNBC-FA member at all times and must not interfere with the use of the lounge by other patrons.
- 8) All UNBC-FAL members who wish to have access to the lounge must understand the rules and regulations of the UNBC-FAL. A valid UNBC photo employee ID card with magnetic strip is required to access the lounge and is activated through submission of this form.
- 9) Members should notify UNBC-FAL committee members (Art Fredeen, Ken Otter, and/or Zoe Meletis) with maintenance issues or suggestions.
